2018 Results

We are delighted with the results achieved by last year's students.

We achieved 54% A* - B with over 50% of all our students attending Russell Group Universities. Most of our students achieved their first choice University whilst others are packing their bags to embark on a gap year or a high level apprenticeship.

Our potential Medics all enjoyed the feeling of success as did our Oxbridge students. Well done to all our students and our thanks to the staff that have taught them and supported them so well over the course of their studies.

We must extend our thanks to Mrs Hayes, Examinations and Sixth Form Manager who works tirelessly to ensure that Results Day runs smoothly and the students receive their results in good order.

Our Expectations

The school decides whether to authorise absences. All students are expected to be punctual and attend Liverpool College every day. Student Absence

This term is a busy one for our Year 13, as the focus shifts to University applications and EPQ.

UCAS

In terms of UCAS, Oxbridge, Medics and Dentists: Forms must be sent by 15th October, with an internal deadline of 1st October to ensure all forms are thoroughly checked. Everyone else is actively encouraged to complete their forms as soon as possible and ideally by half term at the latest.

Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)

The timeline for EPQ is provided and we expect all Year 13 to adhere to this schedule. The date of the presentation evening, to which parents and guardians are welcome to attend, will be confirmed shortly.

EPQ Timeline 2018

PL refers to the relevant page in the log book that should be completed at that point.

January to February 2018- Find a supervisor, discuss titles/themes

Friday 9 February 2018- EPQ proposal form given to Mr Leeder

March 2018- PL 5. Initial ideas section filled in following meeting with your supervisor.

April 2018- Produce a plan for your project. It gets you lots of marks.

May 2018- Settle on an actual title. Check with Mr Leeder, if needed, that it is okay. Your supervisor should be able to tell you.

May 2018- PL 6, 7, 8. Proposal document filled in. You need to do page 6, your supervisor p7.

Mr Leeder will do page 8 in the future.

June 2018- **PL 9- Planning Review**. Meet with your supervisor before this point to make sure you know exactly what you'll be doing over the summer.

3 September- PL 10- Mid Project Review- at least 3000 words completed or artefact created.

Re-entry to Y13 is dependent upon progress in the EPQ.

17 September- First full draft (5000 words, or artefact and words) handed in.

It will be returned by the start of half term holiday at the latest.

I October - Project Finished. PLII - Project product Review

TBC- EPQ presentation evening. PL 12

22 October- PL 14 - Summary Entire project/logbook handed in.
