Dear Year 7, 8 and 9 Parents/Carers,

We very much look forward to welcoming all our pupils back for the first full day of school on Thursday 3rd September.

As promised, in the previously sent out document 'Return to School 2020', I write to outline arrangements for the first day of school and to give more information on some other aspects of school life.

The First day. Thursday 3 September 2020

Pupils to arrive **between 8.15am and 8.20am for an 8.25am start.**

Pupils should not arrive at school before **8.15am.**

On arrival, all pupils **must go immediately their classroom, which is detailed in the table below:**

Other aspects of school life

Meals and Snacks

Break

During break we will be selling snacks in the form of toast, sausage sandwiches and water. These will be sold in the pupils' designated safe areas and will require payment by cash.

Lunchtime

All pupils are expected eat a school meal at lunchtime. The 'return to school 2020' document outlines where pupils will be eating. We are still using the Biometric system and therefore, for those families paying for school meals, money should be paid into the 'parent

pay' facility. I would like to reassure you that we have created a hygiene procedure around the use of the thumb print machine.

School Bags

All pupils are required to bring a school bag, but items in the bag should be kept to a minimum. We suggest that items should be limited to a filled pencil case and essential equipment such as a calculator, a notebook (this can be the House journal, which can be purchased from school on the first day, for £2), a filled water bottle and tissues (we are promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach to coughing and sneezing).

Please note that House Spaces will be closed, this means that pupils will have to carry their personal belongings with them at all times.

PE/Games and DT

The changing rooms are closed and therefore require pupils who have PE or Games on any one day to come to College in their PE kit and Blazer. As an addition, if pupils also have DT on the same day as PE/Games they need to bring in their PE tracksuit bottoms, which can be put on just before their DT lesson over their shorts/under their skorts, or the PE tracksuit bottoms can be worn all day, instead of the shorts/skorts.

Saturday Sport

Saturday sport will commence on 5th September for all Year 7s and the Year 9 rugby squad. Logistics have been sent, by the Director of Sport, to the relevant families.

Thank you for reading this additional information. I am very much aware that this is a worrying time for all. Please try not to worry about the safety of your children in school. We have worked very hard and have extremely careful and well thought out procedures and routines in place to keep our College community as safe as we possibly can.
