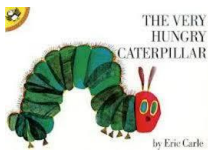
You can then click on to Lent Term/Year group and look for your child's class.

# Book Fair

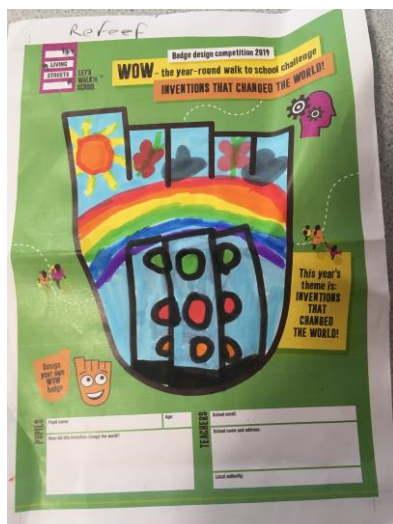
Thank you to all the parents/guardians/grandparents that came to the Pre-Prep Book Fair we have raised a fabulous £540.00 for books to be used in school.
