

Parents of children in Years 3 to 6 are to take their child to his/her form teacher, in the Cathedral, between 11.30 – 11.45am and collect them from the same place at the end of the service. **All children should wear blazers NO CARDIGANS OR JUMPERS.** Shoes to be polished. Girls should have their hair tied up, no big bows or glittery hair pieces.

**There will be no Orchestra on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October**









## Commutative

Commutative is a property of a mathematical operation (as addition or multiplication) in which the result does not depend on the order of the elements. The **commutative** property of addition states that  $1 + 2$  and  $2 + 1$  will both have a sum of 3

commutative law, rule or property

addition



$$a + b = b + a$$

$$6 + 2 = 8 \text{ and } 2 + 6 = 8$$

multiplication



$$a \times b = b \times a$$

or

$$ab = ba$$

$$3 \times 2 = 6 \text{ and } 2 \times 3 = 6$$

in addition and multiplication, numbers may be added or multiplied together in any order

For subtraction and division the order is most important and must not be changed as this results in different answers, e.g.  $8 - 2 = 6$  but  $2 - 8 = -6$ ,  $6 \div 3 = 2$  but  $3 \div 6 = 0.5$


