All pupils from Y3 and Y5 were given the opportunity to work as real detectives on Tuesday when they participated in a forensics workshop.

The students were given a demonstration about how science works in the real world. As they came into the Prep school, they were faced with crime tape. The school dog had been dognapped! Unfortunately, the perpetrator of the crime had left behind some clues. The pupils had to practice their science and investigative skills in a real-life context - observing, exploring and asking questions - to piece together the evidence. Clues and evidence were identified, collected, interpreted and analysed. These include fingerprints, impressions, hairs and fibres and 'blood', bones and DNA. The students were highly engaged in the task and learnt a great deal about the real-life work of forensic scientists. Well done Prep detectives.



Engineering Competition 5-19yrs

ALL pupils in Liverpool College are participating in



this year's Engineering Leaders competition. On Friday, Mrs Doran launched the school wide competition and posed the question - "If you were an Engineer, what would you do?" Children need to think of a problem and think of an idea to solve the problem. It can be any invention at all. Previous winners have designed trolleys with adjustable heights, satellites to increase light levels in counties with high levels of SAD syndrome, cars with self-tinting windows, aeroplane carry on with a built in pram and outdoor washing lines with built in solar panels to aid air circulation. Literally anything goes.

Pupils will be drawing out their designs in Art lessons next week. It would be most appreciated if parents could please talk to their children about the project and discuss any possible ideas with them so they are prepared for the lesson.
