We are updating our selection of books to add more diverse and inclusive titles. It is important that all children see themselves in stories and that all children are seen.

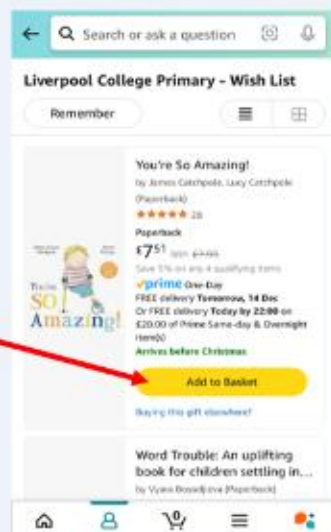

If you would like to donate a book to our library, for classes to enjoy, we would really appreciate it! Please follow the link or scan the QR code to reach our Amazon Wish List.

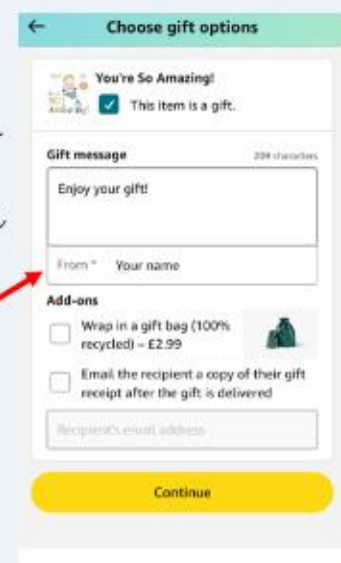

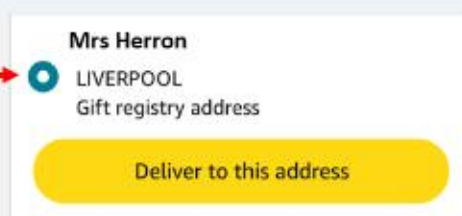

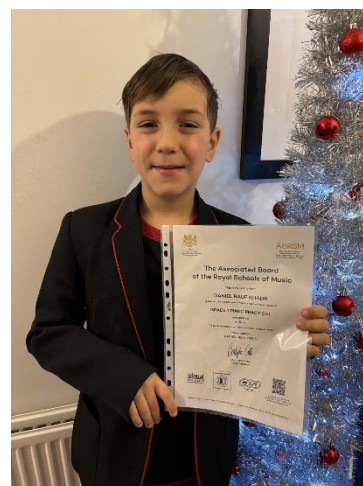
