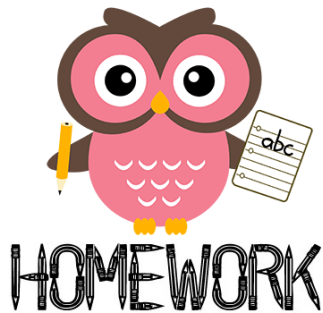

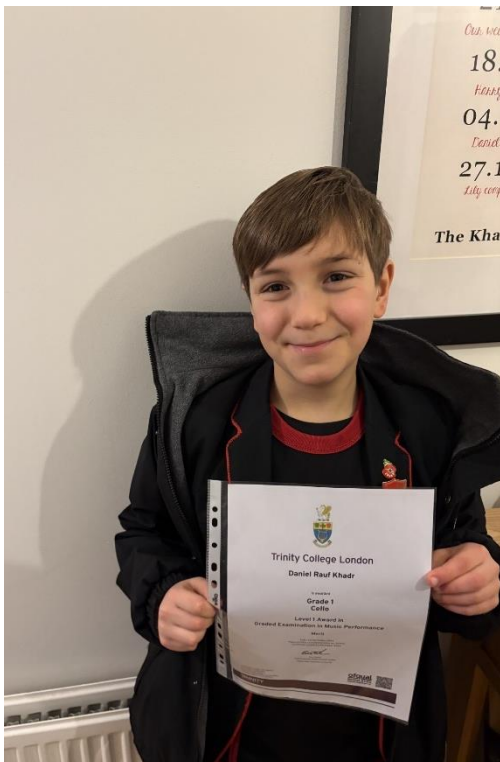




Congratulations to Jack who is appearing in "Annie" the musical at the Liverpool Empire Theatre this week having an amazing time as an orphan

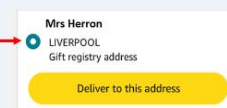

## **INSTRUMENTAL SHOWCASE - WEDNESDAY 22ND JANUARY - 6PM**

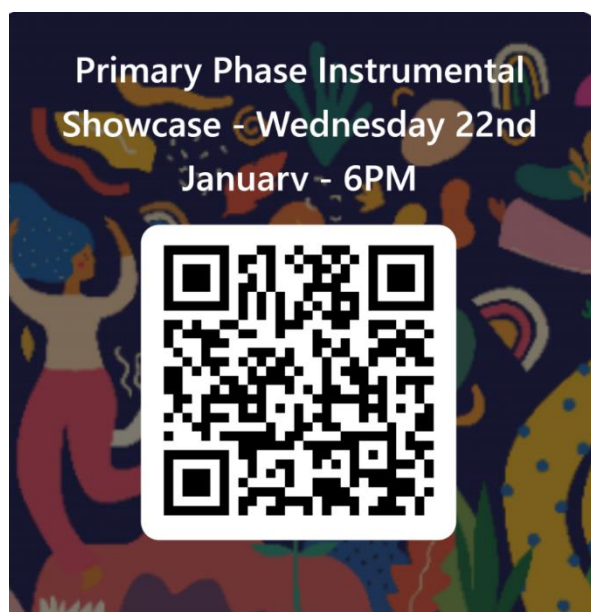
Does your child take instrumental lessons? Have they been preparing and practicing really hard? Would they like to share their progress and achievements?
