Year 5 STEMBOTICS challenge Day

All Year 5 students enjoyed a superb robotics workshop on Thursday when they were challenged to design, build and code Lego robots using LEGO Spike Prime, and then to programme them using a robot interface similar to Scratch. Students were presented with a series of challenges to programme the robots to move around mazes on different floor challenge mats. Students coded their robots in an interface that is very similar to Scratch, reinforcing and extending prior learning from the computing curriculum, including core coding principles such as sequencing, selection and iteration, encouraging also teamwork, problem-solving and resilience. This highly engaging workshop was STEMtastic!
