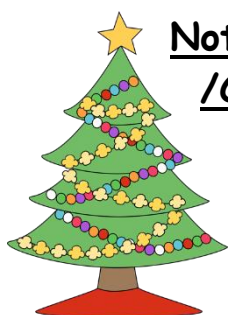

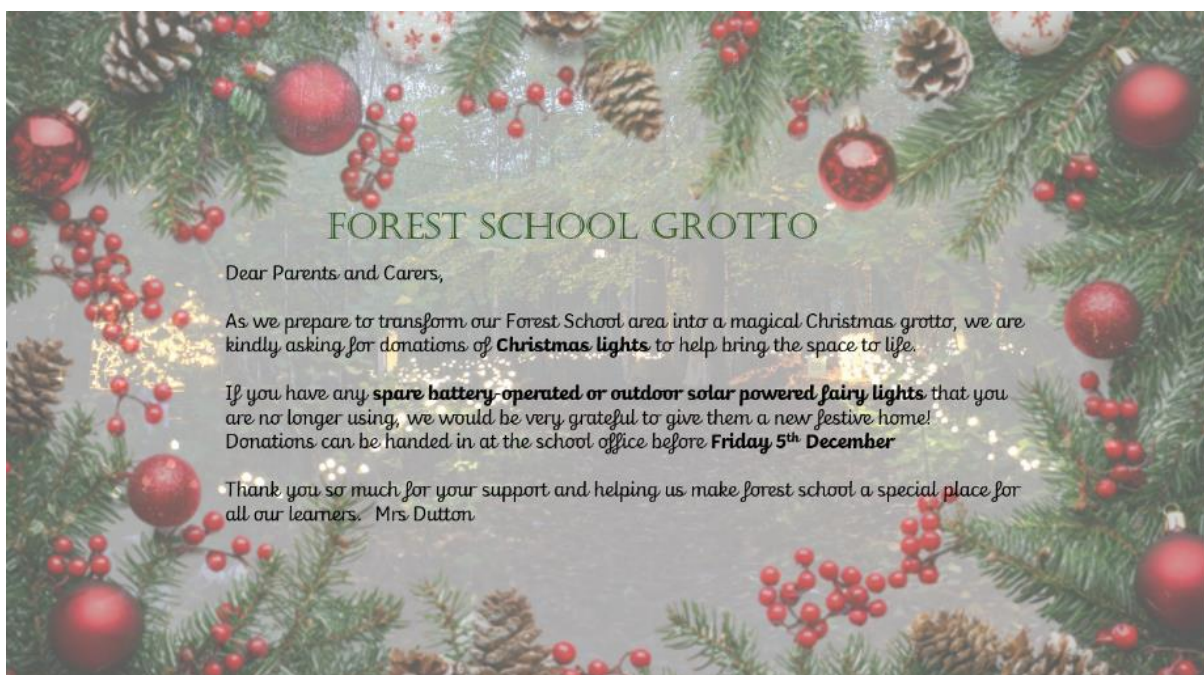


Headteacher's Award

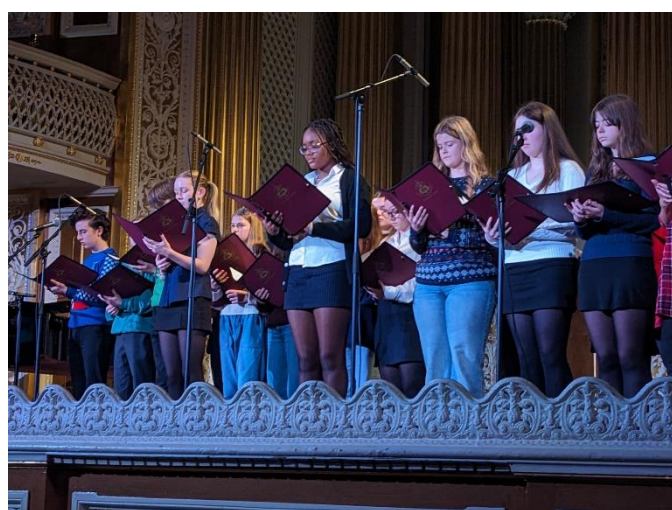

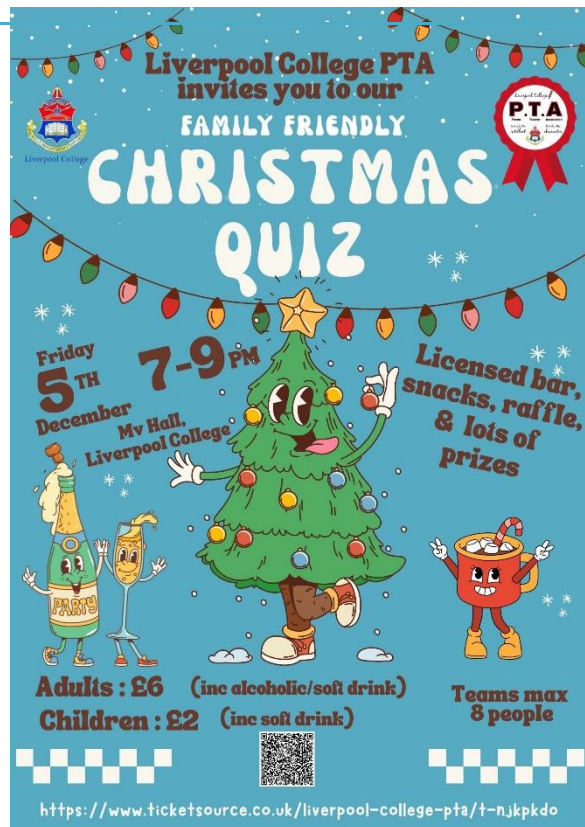
