



Sporting Club Merseyside will continue their offering of after school football at Liverpool College into term 2 of 2025/26 school year. From <u>January</u>, Years 2, 3,4,5 & 6 will continue to train on Wednesdays.

All training sessions are given by FA Licensed Coaches who are highly experienced with coaching kids. The training sessions are designed and monitored by a UEFA Pro License coach. The main focus of the training sessions will be the children's enjoyment - and the sessions are given in a supportive and positive environment, and in a fun way.

What a great way to spend a Sunday afternoon!






