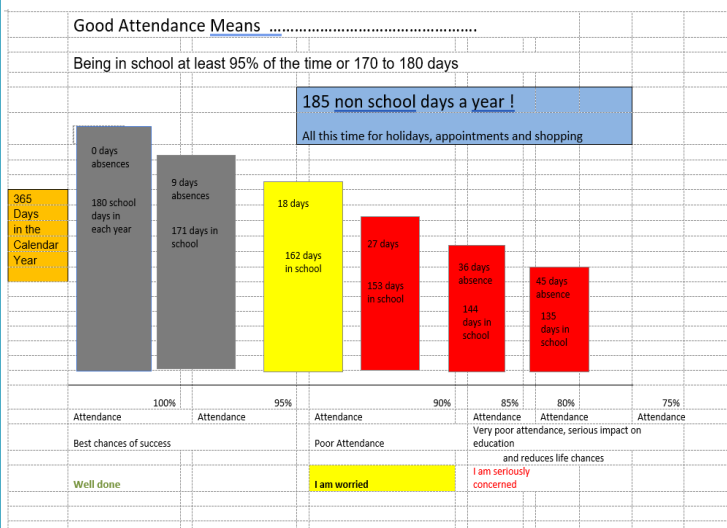
Phonics News
