Wonka Bars

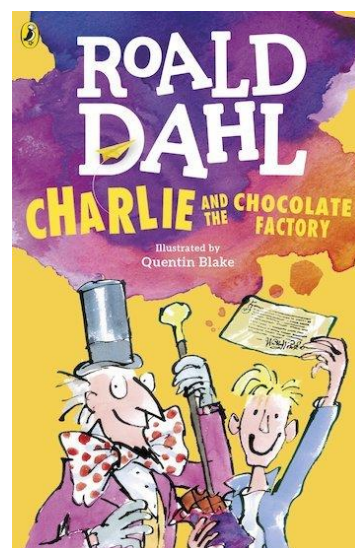
