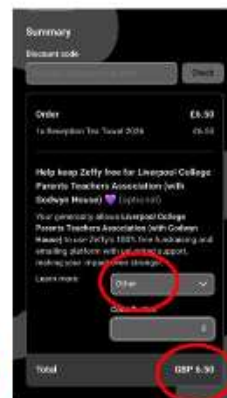


Tea Towels are now on sale and are £6.50 each. You will be asked to input your child's name and class. This is so we can deliver the order to their classes.
