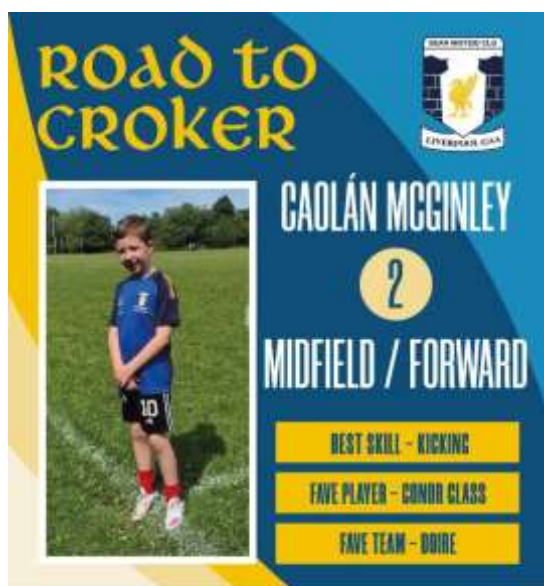
Congratulations to Rory who recently got a distinction in his Grade 1 ukulele exam

Drop off and collection of primary pupils (Reception-Chapter 6)
