School Times

Please adhere to the
timings for your child's

year group. We have staggered the starting and finishing times for your child's year group following the Government guidelines. Please keep to the times listed below for your child's year group. Thank you

ALL PARENTS ARE TO WEAR FACE MASKS TO DROP OFF AND COLLECT THEIR CHILD FROM SCHOOL.

Thank you for your patience when queuing to drop off/ pick up. For the children's safety please do not group round the gate, or trees or shout your child to come but join the line. The staff will call the children when they can see the parent at the front of the line.

WHEN YOU HAVE COLLECTED YOUR CHILD YOU MUST WALK AWAY FROM SCHOOL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

All parents/carers must continue social distancing outside school.

Drop off and Pick up Routines

Parents are to stand on the line markings from the Pre Prep pedestrian gate to Sefton Park.

Reception children are to come into school at **8.15am – 8.30am from Monday 14th September.**

Parents are to come to the Pre Prep gate and a staff member will lead your child into school.

Reception

When collecting your child you are to be at school for **3.00pm – 3.15pm Monday 14th September.**

Year 1 children are to come into school at **8.30am – 8.45am.** Parents are drop off their child at the Pre-Prep gate.

When collecting your child you are to be at school for **3.15pm – 3.30pm**

Year 2 children are to come into school at 8.45am – 9.00am. Parents are to come to the Pre-Prep gate to drop off their child. When collecting your child you are to be at school for **3.30pm – 3.45pm**

All children must be in school by 9.00am at the latest to ensure that the lunch order is complete and lessons can begin promptly.

When dropping off & picking up children from school:



• **Space out & maintain 2 metres**

• **If it is not possible please wear a face covering**



Parking

Mr Broekman has asked me to remind all parents/carers to be considerate when parking.

'The greatest risk to public health at our school remains the parking of parents. It strikes me as sadly inevitable that eventually someone will be hurt by the habit of some parents who park on the opposite side of the road from the Pre Prep and Prep and then undertake a treacherous crossing of the road, usually clutching a small child or two and carrying some bags while the blood pressure and road rage of other road users increases exponentially. Now is the time to stop this before the days grow shorter and visibility declines'.

After School Club

After School starts for **Reception** children on **Monday 14th September**.

Can I ask parents to collect between 4.15-4.30 for session one and 5.15-5.30 for session two.

As much as possible children will be outside for After School Club and will be collected from the playground gate.

In inclement weather children will leave from the Sutton Timmis Hall.

Please Note:

Social Distancing and entry and exit of school for Breakfast Club and Afterschool Club :

Please be responsible for your child(rens) and your own social distancing.

The biggest challenge for us all is the collection and drop off of children. We are following Government guidelines in order to ensure children and staff are safe, to keep school open and children learning.

- We ask one adult only to drop off and collect your child from site to reduce the number of people on site.
- The adult collecting must wear a mask or face covering to collect and drop off their child (Unless medically exempt)
- Can you please wait patiently if there is a queue to collect or drop off your child. There are clearly marked lines from the pedestrian gate to the playground gate.
- There will also be 2 metre marks to guide families (along the Sutton Timmis Hall).
- Please drop and collect your child in a timely and safe manner avoiding contact and social interactions with other parents/carers.
