**Maths** has seen pupils working on multiplication and division; solving some challenging problems.

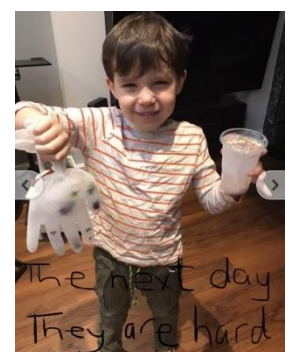
Lots of research and some exciting experiments have been carried out as part of our Super Scientists.
